# **Overview**

The 2022-23 school year was the Athletic Booster Club's fifth year in operation at PFPS's facility in Springfield.

#### FINANCIAL

Kathy Nelson and Kate Day worked together to reconcile receipts and make payments to vendors quickly. Going forward, the Booster Club will continue to use Purchase Orders prior to ordering any merchandise so we have better reporting and accountability of merchandise purchased. The final balance of the 22-23SY was \$9302.00.

#### **CONCESSION STAND**

Tina Wegrzyn ran the concession stands operation and the purchasing of items. We opened the outside concession stand through the Fall and Spring. The Winter concession stand provided larger revenue to the Booster Club due to the strong parent involvement. We were able to expand on our merchandise sales.

### BANQUETS

Banquets transitioned to Sports Appreciation Nights for athletes. An event was held for the Fall, Winter and Spring seasons. The Fall format was all athletes gather for a shared celebration of awards and split into team centered celebrations. The Winter and Spring were team-oriented celebrations.

#### SPIRIT WEAR

We continued to purchase from locally owned printing companies that provided faster service and a boost in community revenue for local businesses. We restocked our inventory several times with new inventory of pajama bottoms, team specific shirts and new styles of hoodies and they sold quickly.

#### **VOLUNTEERS** -

Concession/Volunteering chairperson Tina Wegrzyn continued to use the Signup Genius volunteering app, and it was extremely efficient in all fall/winter/spring games. This year we

continued to invite students to earn community service hours by volunteering their time at the concession stand. It became an increasing popular service and provide students with the responsibilities of setting up for sales, selling merchandise and food, financial accounting and clean-up of the area. The Booster Club will continue this practice in the 2023-2024 SY.
